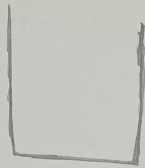

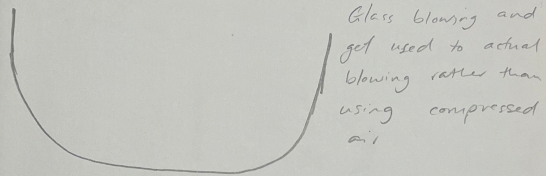

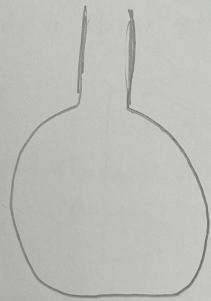

For week 1 we mainly focused on these 3 objects in order to regain some form in





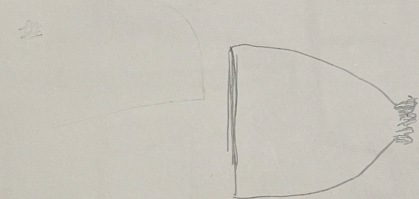

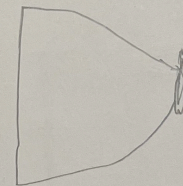

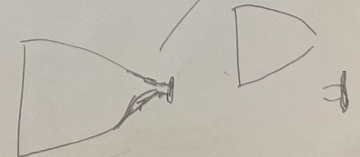
Pinch opening with tweezers.

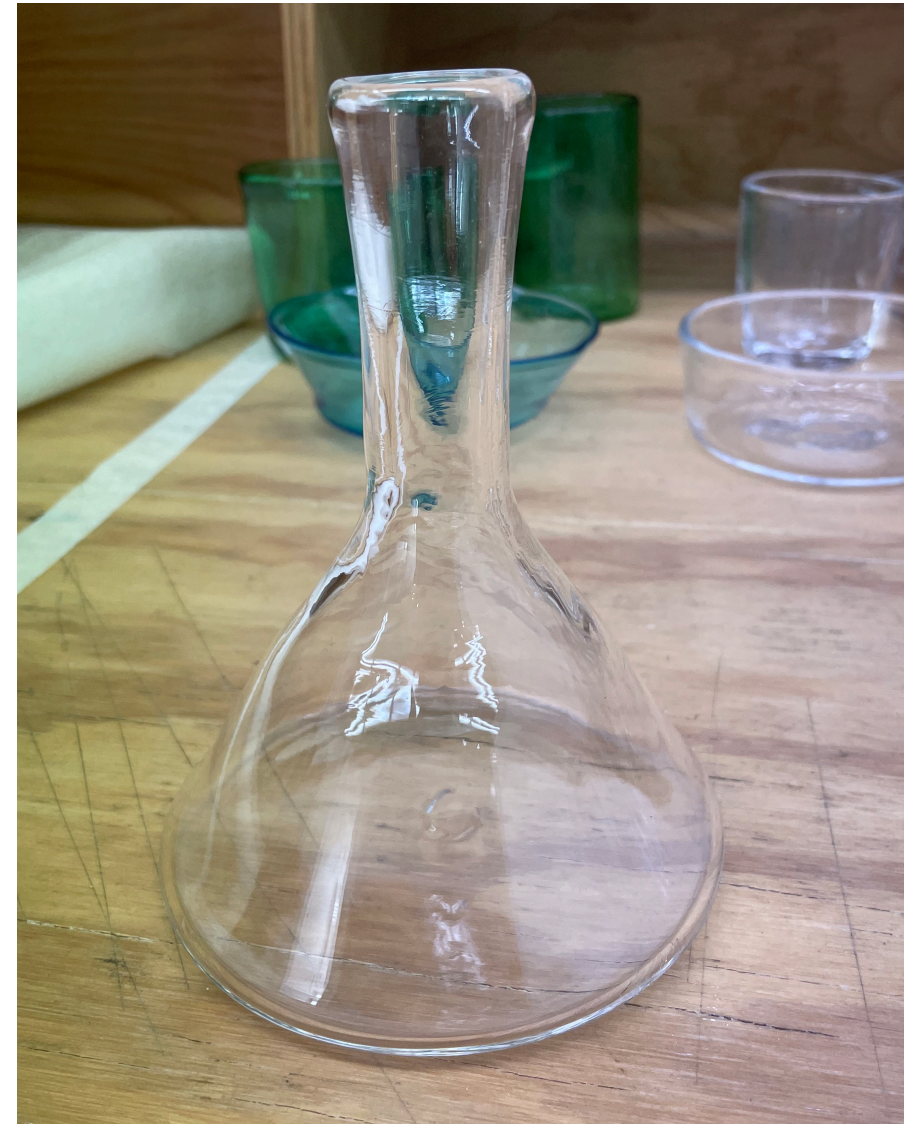
